



Recovery Walk Scotland 2017 – Travel Information

How are you getting to the Recovery Walk?

We would like to provide you with some information on travelling to and from the event as below:

Coach Travel

If you are travelling by coach, your coach can drop you off on South Victoria Dock Road we have a limited number of coach spaces within Xplore Dundee bus depo on East Dock Street for coaches to park up and wait to collect you from Magdalen Green at the Riverside Pavilion football grounds (as coach parking spaces are limited could you please contact us to confirm if you would like a space).

Car Travel

Please prepare details of parking in advance!!

As this year's Recovery Walk is held in two different sites, should you be travelling by car, you might wish to consider parking somewhere that is accessible to Magdalen Green where the event will end, allowing sufficient time to make your way to the roses ceremony by either foot, public transport or taxi. Carparking will be subject to availability when you arrive, however we have identified the following located near Magdalen Green:

- Roseangle Car Park, Dundee, DD1 4NB
- Greenmarket Multi Story Car Park, Dundee, DD1 4QB
- NCP Marketgait Car Park, Dundee, DD11QP

Train

The nearest rail station is Dundee which has direct links from Glasgow Queen Street, Edinburgh Waverley & Aberdeen.
